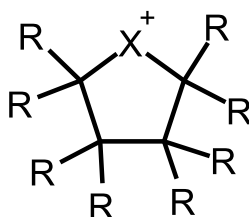
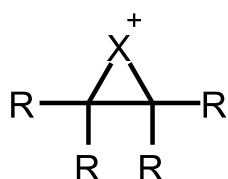


halonium ions

Ions of the form R_2X^+ , where X is any halogen ($X = Br^+$, bromonium ions; $X = Cl^+$, chloronium ions; $X = F^+$, fluoronium ions; $X = I^+$, iodonium ions). They may be open-chain or cyclic.
